### Marko Škreb

Born in 1957 in Zagreb, Croatia. Graduated with a B.Sc. degree in Economics and later received his Ph.D. degree in Economics, both from the University of Zagreb.

From 1996 to 2000 he worked at the Croatian Central Bank, first as a Research and Statistics Director and later on as a Governor of the Croatian National Bank. At the same time he was Governor for the International Monetary Fund and held different positions within Croatia. While working for the IMF and the World Bank, he was involved in a number of projects in various countries. He spent a year working at the Independent Evaluation Office of the IMF in Washington DC.

Prior to 1996, he was teaching macroeconomics at the University of Zagreb as an assistant lecturer and later as associate professor. He has published numerous articles and edited books on, among other topics, financial crises and transition economics. In 1997 he was awarded the Central European Annual Awards for Excellence - Best Central Bank Governor and by Euromoney Publications - Best Eastern European Banker and in 2000 delivered the Jacques de Larosiere EBRD Annual Lecture in Riga, Latvia.
